IDM Monitor Standard Operating Procedures

LEKGOTLA 4

Lekgotla 4 is a single room (previously Lekgotla 4A and Lekgotla 4B, the dividers are to be kept

open)

SWITCH on the Monitor(s), Press "**ON**" remote button (*if the monitor takes a while to turn on press the* **ON** *button behind the monitor, press and hold the* **ON** *button till monitor is switched* **ON**)

HDMI Matrix Switch is behind the Monitor in seminar room previously Lekgotla 4A.

If Using One Monitor:

- Individual room projection in seminar room previously Lekgotla 4A, ensure that 1 is selected on the 4X4 HDMI Matrix Switch for 4A output switch. HDMI Cable in 4A must be connected to the laptop port.
- Individual room projection in seminar room previously Lekgotla 4B, ensure that 2 is selected on the 4X4 HDMI Matrix Switch for 4B output switch. HDMI Cable in 4B must be connected to the laptop port.

OR

If Using Both Monitors:

- Dual room projection, ensure that 1 is selected on the 4X4 HDMI Matrix Switch for both 4A and 4B outputs. HDMI Cable in 4A must be connected to the laptop port.
- Dual room projection, ensure that 2 is selected on the 4X4 HDMI Matrix Switch for both 4A and 4B outputs. HDMI Cable in 4B must be connected to the laptop port.

HDMI CABLE CONNECTION

Press "OK" and select "Any Language, Any Continent, and Any Country"- It doesn't matter what options are selected.

The Monitor(s) will show "Automatic time of 4 hrs", press "OK" on the remote.

The Monitor will show "**No Signal**", immediately press "**Input**" on the remote, and select the **HDMI** option from the Input List.
